Bada Yuanlao	八大元老	The Eight Immortals
Deng Xiaoping	邓小平	(1904-1997)
Li Xiannian	李先念	(1909-1989)
Chen Yun	陈云	(1905-1995)
Peng Zhen	彭真	(1902-1997)
Yang Shangkun	杨尚昆	(1907-1998)
Bo Yibo	薄一波	(1908-2007)
Wang Zhen	王震 ((1908-1993)
Song Renqiong	宋任穷	(1909-2005)
Bo Xilai	薄熙来	Son of Bo Yibo and former Chongqing (重庆) Party Boss, now disgraced
Wan Li	万里	Chairman of the Standing Committee of the National People's Congress and long time leader and Deng Xiaoping ally
Taiyuan	太原	Capital of Shanxi 山西 Province, birthplace of Bo Yibo
Tianjin	天津	Municipality on China – subject of a future podcast
Li Fuchun	李富春	Worked closely with Bo Yibo managing China's economy in the 50's and 60's. Also a future podcast topic.
Wenhua Dageming	文化大革命	The Cultural Revolution
Yan Xishan	阎锡山	Warlord and later loyal KMT general. Allied with Bo Yibo's Shanxi Suicide Squad during the war of resistance against Japan.

Jiang Qing	江青	Mao's wife, Gang of 4 Member and tormenter of Bo Yibo during the Cultural Revolution
Kang Sheng	康生	Godfather of the Cultural Revolution, Mao's lifelong ally, China's Secret Police founder. See more about Kang at CHP episode 11
Hu Yaobang	胡耀邦	Former CCP General Secretary, later disgraced
Zhao Ziyang	赵紫阳	Succeeded Hu Yaobang to the top position in the Party but later disgraced for his handling of the Tiananmen Incident
Liu Binyan	刘宾雁	Writer and dissident during the 80's along with Wang Ruowang and Fang Lizhi
Wang Ruowang	王若望	Writer and dissident, passed away in 2001 in New York City
Fang Lizhi	方励之	Scientist, dissident, passed away April 6, 2012 in Tucson, AZ
Genzhe dang de luxian	跟着党的路线	To follow the Party Line
Zhou Xiaochuan	周小川	China princeling who now serves as Governor of the People's Bank of China
