Chi	尺	A chinese foot, about 1/3 of a meter
Daxinganling	大兴安岭	The Great Khingan Mountain Range
Empress Dowager Yingtian	应天皇后	Wife of Abaoji
Hancheng	汉城	The Chinese City (also the modern name of Seoul, ROK)
Huangchao Qiyi	黄巢起义	The Huang Chao Rebellion
Li Cunxu	李存勖	Son of Li Keyong, founder of Later Tang Dynasty
Li Keyong	李克用	Father of Li Cunxu, built Shatuo Turk power base in Shanxi
Li Siyuan	李嗣源	Second emperor of the Later Tang Dynasty
Ouyang Xiu	欧阳修	Song dynasty statesman, calligrapher, essayist, official
Qidan	契丹	The Khitan People
Shangjing	上京	The Supreme Capital
Shatuo Turks	沙陀突厥	Turkic people from the steppes, influential in Tang and founded 3 of the Five Dynasties
Shi Jingtang	石敬瑭	Founder of Later Jin Dynasty, a puppet dynasty of the Khitans
Taiyuan	太原	Capital of Shanxi Province
Tang Taizong	唐太宗	Tang Dyansty emperor who also reigned at its peak
Tang Xuanzong	唐玄宗	Tang Dyansty emperor who reigned at its peak

Xianbei	鲜卑	Early Mongol people
Xiongnu	匈奴	Early steppe people in the north and northwest of China
Yelü Abaoji	耶律阿保机	Liao dynasty founder
Zhu Wen	朱温	Later Liang Dynasty founder
