Cai Bian	蔡卞	Younger brother of Cai Jing. Also a chancellor and famed calligrapher
Cai Jing	蔡京	Northern Song official, later to play a major role in Huizong's reign. One of the greatest calligraphers of his day. Brother of Cai Bian
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Chen Guan	陈贯	Conservative faction stalwart
Chongning	崇宁	Huizong's second era name 1102-1106
Da Jingzhi	晁浄之	Successor to Liu Hunkang as Master of the Highest Clarity Movement
Daguan	大观	Huizong's 3rd era name 1107-1110
Empress Dowager Xiang	向太后	Empress of Emperor Shenzong
Han Zhongyan	韩忠彦	Senior chancellor during Huizong's reign
Huizong	徽宗	Song Dynasty emperor who reigned 1100-1127
Jianzhong Jingguo	建中靖国	Huizong's first era name 1100-1101
Jinshi	进士	The degree received after passing the 3 year civil service exam
Kaifeng	开封	City in Henan, Capital of the Northern Song
King Helü	阖闾	The warrior king of the state of Wu. (see CHP-111)
Laozi	老子	Lao Tzu, "founder" of Daoism
Li Ji	礼记	The Book of Rites

Li Jie	李誠	China's greatest architect of ancient time, author of the 营造法式 Yingzao Fashi
Li Yu	李煜	Last ruler of the Southern Tang (5 Dynasties 10 Kingdoms Period), developer of the "gold inlaid knife" style of calligraphy
Liu Hunkang	劉混康	Great Daoist master. b. 1035, d. 1108
Lü Yijian	呂夷簡	Chancellor under the Renzong emperor
Maoshan	茅山	Mountain in Jiangsu, home of the Shangqing School of Daoism
Nianhao	年号	Era Names
Qinshihuang	秦始皇	The first Qin Emperor, Ying Zheng
Renzong	仁宗	The fourth Song emperor
San Li	三礼	The Three Li's: The Rites of Zhou, Book of Etiquette and Rites, The Book of Rites
Shangqing	上清	The Highest Clarity Movement, popular Daoist movement located at Mt. Mao
Shaosheng	紹聖	Second era of Emperor Zhezong's reign
Shenzong	神宗	6th Song emperor, father of Huizong
Shou jin ti	瘦金体	Slender Gold Style of calligraphy developed early in his reign by Huizong
Siku Quanshu	四库全书	The Complete Library of the Four Treasuries is the largest collection of Chinese books ever compiled into a single work. This was a work called for by the Qing Dynasty Qianlong emperor
Sima Guang	司马光	Song historian and politician known for his conservative bent
Sishu Wujing	四书五经	The Four Books and the Five Classics
Su Shi	苏轼	Great politician, conservative faction tour de force and local Hangzhou hometown hero
Sunzi	孙子	Wrote the Art of War
Wang Anshi	王安石	Reformer during Shenzong emperor
Wang Dan	王旦	Chancellor under Zhenzong
Yi Li	仪礼	Book of Etiquette and Rites

<b>Yingzao Fashi</b>	<b>营造法式</b>	The Song work: Treatise on Architectural Methods. Also known as the State Building Standards
<b>Yuanyou</b>	<b>元祐</b>	The first era of Emperor Zhezong's reign
<b>Zeng Bu</b>	<b>曾布</b>	Junior Chief Councillor and trusted advisor to Huizong as soon as he became emperor
<b>Zhang Dun</b>	<b>章惇</b>	Chancellor before Cai Jing
<b>Zhao Kuangyin</b>	<b>赵匡胤</b>	Song emperor Taizu, founder of the Song
<b>Zhenzong</b>	<b>真宗</b>	3rd Song emperor and big time believer and supporter of Daoism
<b>Zhezong</b>	<b>哲宗</b>	7th Song emperor, older brother of Huizong
<b>Zhou Li</b>	<b>周礼</b>	The Rites of Zhou
