Charles Wang	王嘉廉	CA Associates International co-founder (born in Shanghai)
Daoguang Emperor	道光帝	Qing dynasty emperor during Opium Wars
Dengzhou	登州	Present day Penglai, where Wong Chin Foo lived
Gary Locke	骆家辉	Former Washington State governor and US ambassador to China
Hua Mei Xin Bao	华美新报	The Chinese American, Wong's first paper
Huang	黄	Surname (means "yellow") pronounced Wong in Cantonese
I.M. Pei	贝聿铭	Chinese American architect (born in Guangzhou)
Jimo	即墨	City of Wong Chin Foo's birth, just north of Qingdao
Judy Chu	赵美心	U.S. Representative from California's 27th Congressional District
Nancy Kwan	关家蒨	1960's actress (born in Hong Kong)
Ng Poon Chew	伍盤照	Started the first Chinese language newspaper in the US. (born in Taishan)
Norman Assing	袁生	Community leader in San Francisco's Chinatown

Penglai	蓬莱	City in north Shandong, formerly called Dengzhou
Qingdao	青岛	Beautiful coastal city in Shandong
Samuel C.C. Ting	丁肇中	Won Nobel Prize in 1976 in Physics (born in Ann Arbor)
Shandong	山东	Province in China
Steven Chu	朱棣文	Won Nobel Price in Physics 1997. US Secretary of Energy 2009-13. (born in St. Louis)
T.D. Lee	李政道	Won Nobel in Physics in 1957 (born in Shanghai)
Vivienne Tam	谭燕玉	Fashion designer (born in Guangzhou)
Wang	五	Surname (means "king") pronounced Wong in Cantonese
Wong Chin Foo	王清福	The subject of today's episode (Pinyin: Wang Qingfu)
Wong Sa Kee	王缓祺	Wong Chin Foo's earliest name
Wong Yen Ping	王彦平	Another name Wong Chin Foo went by
Xianfeng Emperor	咸丰帝	Qing Dynasty emperor
Yantai	烟台	Coastal city in Shandong
Y o-yo Ма	马友友	One of the greatest cellists of his age (born in France)
Yung Wing	容闳	First Chinese to graduate from a US university (1854) (from Guangdong, Xiangshan)
Zhenjiang	镇江	City on the Yangzi River in Jiangsu
Zhifu	芝罘	Early name for Yantai
