| Chaoshan             | 潮汕      | Abbreviation for Chaozhou-Shantou                              |
| Chaozhou and Shantou | 潮州和汕头   | The twin cities of Chaozhou and Shantou in Guangdong           |
| Chen Duxiu           | 陈独秀     | CCP Co-Founder   |
| Chen Jitang          | 陈济棠     | A Hakka NRA general who turned on Chiang Kai-shek              |
| Chen Yi              | 陈毅      | Great general, Shanghai mayor, Foreign Minister                |
| Dai Li               | 戴笠      | Chiang Kai-shek's secret police chief                          |
| Deng Yingchao        | 邓颖超     | Wife and lifelong partner of Zhou Enlai                        |
| Du Yuesheng          | 杜月笙     | Shanghai "Green Gang" crime boss                               |
| Duan Qirui           | 段祺瑞     | China statesman and Anhui Clique warlord                       |
| Feng Yuxiang         | 冯玉祥     | The "Christian Warlord" of the Zhili Clique                    |
| Futian Incident      | 富田事变    | December 1930 incident where a mutinous battalian was put down |
| Fuxing lu            | 复兴路     | Road in Shanghai formerly known as Rue Lafayette               |
| Gu Shunzhang         | 顾顺章     | Early CCP leader and later betrayer                            |
| Guizhou              | 贵州      | Western province in China                                      |
| He Long              | 贺龙      | Great Red Army general, one of the Ten Marshals                |

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| <b>Huai'an</b>       | <b>淮安</b>   | Located in Jiangsu, birthplace of Zhou Enlai   |
| <b>Jinggangshan</b>  | <b>井冈山</b>  | The cradle of the revolution, where Mao went after the Autumn Harvest Uprising   |
| <b>Kang Sheng</b>    | <b>康生</b>   | Early CCP secret police chief and later “godfather” of the Cultural Revolution   |
| <b>Li Dazhao</b>     | <b>李大钊</b>  | CCP Co-Founder   |
| <b>Li De</b>         | <b>李德</b>   | Chinese name of Comintern agent Otto Braun   |
| <b>Li Lisan</b>      | <b>李立三</b>  | Xiang’s right hand who also played a leadership role   |
| <b>Lin Biao</b>      | <b>林彪</b>   | Great Red Army general, one of the Ten Marshals  |
| <b>Liping</b>        | <b>黎平</b>   | City in eastern Guizhou  |
| <b>Lu Xun</b>        | <b>鲁迅</b>   | One of the greatest writers of his age   |
| <b>Mao Dun</b>       | <b>矛盾</b>   | real name 沈德鸿, great writer and former Minister of Culture   |
| <b>Miao</b>          | <b>苗族</b>   | In Vietnam they’re known as the Hmong. General term for a diverse minority people in China (as well as Laos, Vietnam). Over 200,000 in the US. |
| <b>Nanchang</b>      | <b>南昌</b>   | Capital of Jiangxi Province  |
| <b>Nie Rongzhen</b>  | <b>聂荣臻</b>  | Great Red Army general, one of the Ten Marshals  |
| <b>Ningdu</b>        | <b>宁都</b>   | Site of a famous pre-Zunyi Conference CCP meeting  |
| <b>Peng Dehuai</b>   | <b>彭德怀</b>  | Great Red Army general   |
| <b>Qiushou Qiyi</b>  | <b>秋收起义</b> | Mao’s Autumn Harvest Uprising  |
| <b>Qu Qiubai</b>     | <b>瞿秋白</b>  | CCP leader, literary figure and martyr   |
| <b>Ruijin</b>        | <b>瑞金</b>   | City on Fujian-Jiangxi border  |
| <b>Shenyang</b>      | <b>沈阳</b>   | City in Liaoning Province  |
| <b>Song Qingling</b> | <b>宋庆龄</b>  | Madame Sun Yat-sen   |
| <b>Sun Chuanfang</b> | <b>孙传芳</b>  | The Nanking Warlord  |

| The Xinhai Revolution  | 辛亥革命  | The event that began with the Wuchang Uprising 10-10-1911    |
| Tianjin                | 天津    | Major city east of Beijing                                   |
| Wang Jingwei           | 汪精卫   | Early leader of the Republic China                           |
| Wang Ming              | 王明    | Comintern appointed CCP leader and head of the 28 Bolsheviks |
| Wang Shouhua           | 汪寿华   | a key CCP leader in Shanghai and Labor leader                |
| Wu Peifu               | 吴佩孚   | Zhili Clique warlord   |
| Wuhan                  | 武汉    | City in Hubei made up of Wuchang, Hankou and Hanyang         |
| Xiang River            | 湘江    | Largest river in Hunan and a major tributary of the Yangzi   |
| Xiang Ying             | 项英    | Early CCP organizer and leader in the New Fourth Army        |
| Xiang Zhongfa          | 向忠发   | Early CCP leader appointed by the Comintern                  |
| Xu Xiangqian           | 徐向前   | Great Red Army general, one of the Ten Marshals              |
| Ye Ting                | 叶挺    | Red Army general from the early days of the Revolution       |
| Zhang Zuolin           | 张作霖   | The Manchurian Warlord                                       |
| Zhao Shu               | 赵舒    | Led Chiang Kai-shek's 26th Army. Saved Zhou's life           |
| Zhongshan Jian Shijian | 中山舰事件 | The Zhongshan Gunboat Incident                               |
| Zhongyang Teke         | 中央特科  | The CCP secret police (中国共产党中央特别行动科)                         |
| Zhu De                 | 朱德    | Founder of the Red Army                                      |
| Zunyi                  | 遵义    | City just north of Liping                                    |
