Bo Gu	博古	One of the 28 Bolsheviks and right hand to Wang Ming
Bo Yibo	薄一波	Early Mao supporter, featured in an earlier CHP episode
Chen Jiakang	陈家康	Early communist and very close to Zhou Enlai, serving as his chief liaison with foreign journalists
Chen Yi	陈毅	Great general, Shanghai mayor, Foreign Minister
Dali	大理	Formerly known as Xiaguan, city in Yunnan
Deng Yingchao	邓颖超	Wife and lifelong partner of Zhou Enlai
gaiwan	盖碗	covered tea bowls
Gum jie	金姐	Long serving tea lady at the CHP Complex
He Long	贺龙	Great Red Army general, one of the Ten Marshals
He Zizhen	贺子珍	Mao's third wife (after Luo Yixiu and Yang Kaihui)
Hebei	河北	Province in China where Beijing is geographically located (but not part of)
Huai-Hai Campaign	淮海战役	The second of the three great military campaigns 11-6-1948 to 1-10-1949
Huang Hua	黄华	Great Chinese diplomat and vice premier
Jiang Qing	江青	Madame Mao, the name by which she is best known
Jinggangshan	井冈山	The cradle of the revolution, where Mao went after the Autumn Harvest Uprising
Kang Sheng	康生	Early CCP secret police chief and later "godfather" of the Cultural Revolution

Lan Ping	蓝萍	Stage name of Jiang Qing
Li Shumeng	李淑蒙	Early name of Jiang Qing
Li Yunhe	李云鹤	Another early name of Jiang Qing
Li Zongren	李宗仁	Succeeded Chiang as president in January 1949
Liao-Shen Campaign	辽沈战役	The first of the three great military campaigns 9-12-1948 to 11-2-1948
Lin Biao	林彪	Great Red Army general, one of the Ten Marshals
Lingdao	领导	leader
Liu Bei	刘备	Great Sichuan hero and King of Shu. One of the main characters of Romance of the Three Kingdoms
Liu Shaoqi	刘少奇	Early Mao supporter and later top leader in China
Ma Haide	马海德	Dr. George Hatem, subject of a future episode
Menghai Tea Factory	勐海茶厂	Famous tea factory in Xishuangbanna
Nie Rongzhen	聂荣臻	Great Red Army general, one of the Ten Marshals
Ningbo	宁波	Major port city in Zhejiang province
Panlongzhen	蟠龙镇	Place in Shaanxi where Peng Dehuai raided a KMT supply depot
Peng Dehuai	彭德怀	Great Red Army general, one of the Ten Marshals
Peng Zhen	彭真	Early Mao supporter and later mayor of Beijing
Ping-Jin Campaign	平津战役	The last of the three great military campaigns 11-29-1948 to 1-31-1949
Ren Bishi	任弼时	Early political and military communist leader. Died in 1950
Ruijin	瑞金	City on Fujian-Jiangxi border
Shaanxi	陕西	Province in northwest China
Shanxi	山西	Northern province bordering Shaanxi

Shaoshan	韶山	Birthplace of Mao near Xiangtan
Sheng Pu-erh	生普洱	Raw Pu-erh Tea
shiba da	十八大	The 18th Party Congress
Shijiazhuang	石家庄	Capital Hebei Province
Shou Pu-erh	熟普洱	Ripe Pu-erh tea
tuocha	沱茶	usually 100 gram dome shaped tea bricks
Wang Jiaxiang	王稼祥	Another former 28 Bolshevik and Party leader who sided with Mao
Wang Ming	王明	Comintern appointed CCP leader and head of the 28 Bolsheviks
Xiaguan Tea Factory	下关茶厂	Famous tea factory in Dali
Xibaipo	西柏坡	Town near Shijiazhuang that served as Mao's new base after Yan'an
Xikou	溪口	Birthplace of Chiang Kai-shek
Xishuangbanna	西双版纳	One of the great tea cities of China
Yan'an	延安	Revolutionary base of the CCP after the Long March
Ye Jianying	叶剑英	Immortal Communist military leader and statesman
Yunnan	云南	Southwest province of China
Zaolin'gou	枣林沟	Site of a key meeting after Yan'an was evacuated
Zhang Guotao	张国焘	Senior Communist leader and rival to Mao
Zhangjiakou	张家口	City of 4.4 million that borders Beijing, Inner Mongolia and Shanxi
Zhishi fenzi	知识分子	intellectuals
Zhu De	朱德	Founder of the Red Army
Zhuge Liang	诸葛亮	Another main character from Romance of the Three Kingdoms. Wise advisor to Liu Bei
