Hā'ěrbīn	哈尔滨	Capital of Heilongjiang province
Hǎimén Road	海门路	Road in Hongkou where the Japanese Bureau of Stateless Refugee Affairs
Lónghuá	龙华	District in Shanghai
Tiānjīn	天津	Port city just to the east of Beijing
Tōng	通	Pass (to be able to pass through)
Tōngběi Road	通北路	One of the four roads that formed the perimeter of the Shanghai Ghetto
Wú Guójí Nànmín Xiàndìng Dìqū	无国籍难民限定地区	The Restricted Sector for Stateless Refugees a.k.a. The Shanghai Ghetto
