PINYIN / TERM	CHINESE	ENGLISH / MEANING
<b>Chóngqìng</b>	重庆	Municipality in southwest China east of Chengdu. Formerly part of Sichuan.
<b>Guāngxù Emperor</b>	光绪帝	Second to the last Qing emperor. reigned 1875-1908
<b>Guǎngzhōu</b>	广州	Historic port city in southern China. Capital of Guangdong Province
<b>Jiāngxī Road</b>	江西路	One of the major roads of Shanghai
<b>Lǚ Xùn</b>	鲁迅	1881-1936, one of the most admired Chinese writers of the early 20th century
<b>Qīng Dynasty</b>	清朝	China's last imperial dynasty, ran from 1644-1911
<b>Shào Xúnměi</b>	邵洵美	1906-1968, Known around town as Zau Sinmay. Poet, publisher, man about town. He had it good for a while
<b>Sòng Aìlíng</b>	宋霭龄	Chinese businesswoman, and the wife of H. H. Kung, who was the richest man in the early 20th century Republic of China.
<b>Sòng Měilíng</b>	宋美龄	1893-1981, the middle Soong sister, widow of Sun Yat-sen
<b>Sòng Qìnglíng</b>	宋庆龄	1888-1973, a.k.a. Nancy Soong, the oldest of the Soong Sisters
<b>Xiàng Měilì</b>	项美丽	Emily Hahn's Chinese name, given to her by Sinmay's family
