PINYIN / TERM	CHINESE	ENGLISH / MEANING
Chóngqìng	重庆	Municipality in southwest China east of Chengdu. Formerly part of Sichuan.
Guāngxù Emperor	光绪帝	Second to the last Qing emperor. reigned 1875-1908
Guǎngzhōu	广州	Historic port city in southern China. Capital of Guangdong Province
Jiāngxī Road	江西路	One of the major roads of Shanghai
Lǔ Xùn	鲁迅	1881-1936, one of the most admired Chinese writers of the early 20th century
Qīng Dynasty	清朝	China's last imperial dynasty, ran from 1644-1911
Shào Xúnměi	邵洵美	1906-1968, Known around town as Zau Sinmay. Poet, publisher, man about town. He had it good for a while
Sòng Aìlíng	宋霭龄	Chinese businesswoman, and the wife of H. H. Kung, who was the richest man in the early 20th century Republic of China.
Sòng Měilíng	宋美龄	1893-1981, the middle Soong sister, widow of Sun Yat-sen
Sòng Qìnglíng	宋庆龄	1888-1973, a.k.a. Nancy Soong, the oldest of the Soong Sisters
Xiàng Měilì	项美丽	Emily Hahn's Chinese name, given to her by Sinmay's family
