PINYIN / TERM	CHINESE	ENGLISH / MEANING
Lù Xīqí / Luk Shek-kee	陆锡麒	1904-1991, Chinese-American film and television actor, technical advisor and artist and a founding member of the Screen Actors Guild.
Guǎngzhōu	广州	Capital city of Guangdong Province, once known in the west as Canton. Guangzhou is also the Sister City of Los Angeles
Chin Gee Hee	陈宜禧	1844-1929, Toi San born merchant, labor contractor, and railway entrepreneur, who made his fortune in Seattle, Washington before returning to Toi San where he built the Sun Ning Eailway
Yúnnán	云南	Province in southwest China
Xiānféng	咸丰帝	Qing Emperor who reigned 1850-1861
Tóngzhì	同治帝	Qing Emperor who reigned 1861-1875
Guāngxù	光绪帝	Qing Emperor who reigned 1875-1908
Wing Luke / Lù Róngchāng	陆荣昌	1925-1965, a Chinese-American lawyer and politician from Seattle. Luke served as an assistant attorney general of Washington for the state civil rights division from 1957 to 1962. He was later a member of the Seattle City Council 1962 until his death in 1965 in a plane crash. The Wing Luke Museum of the Asian Pacific American Experience is named in his honor.
