| Cao Yiou | 曹轶欧 | Wife of Kang Sheng |
| Chen Boda | 陈伯达 | Chair of the Cultural Revolution Group and Mao's secretary |
| Dazibao | 大字报 | Big Character Poster |
| Diaoyutai Guesthouse | 钓鱼台国宾馆 | China's state guest house and headquarters of the Cultural Revolution Group |
| Guan Feng | 关锋 | Early leftist who supported Yao Wenyuan's inflammatory article regarding Wu Han |
| Jiang Qing | 江青 | Mao's wife and later member of Gang of Four |
| Kang Sheng | 康生 | Close confidante of Mao and founder of China's secret police |
| Ke Qingshi | 柯庆施 | Shanghai Party Boss who died in 1965 |
| Li Xuefeng | 李雪峰 | Succeeded Peng Zhen as Beijing top guy |
| Lin Biao | 林彪 | Successor to Peng Dehuai as defense minister |
| Lu Dingyi | 陆定一 | Minister of Culture |
| Lu Ping | 鲁平 | Peking Univ. leader targeted by Nie Yuanzi's big character poster |
| Luo Ruiqing | 罗瑞卿 | General of the army and enemy of Lin Biao, later brought down by Lin |
| Lushan | 庐山 | Scenic city in Jiangxi Province, site of the Lushan Conference |
| Nie Rongzhen | 聂荣臻 | Marshal of the PLA |
| Nie Yuanzi | 聂元梓 | Peking Univ. professor who wrote the Big Character Poster that created one of the sparks that ignited the Cultural Revolution |

| Peng Dehuai | 彭德怀 | Defense Minister sacked and disgraced during the Great Leap Forward for daring to speak up to Mao |
| Peng Zhen | 彭真 | Mayor and Party Boss of Beijing |
| Qi Benyu | 戚本禹 | Hardcore leftist during the Cultural Revolution |
| Shaoshan | 韶山 | Town in Hunan, birthplace of Chairman Mao |
| Tao Zhu | 陶铸 | Leftist leader during the Cultural Revolution, succeeded Lu Dingyi |
| Ulanfu | 乌兰夫 | Mongol high ranking member of the government |
| Wang Dongxing | 汪东兴 | Major General and head of unit 8341, the palace guard |
| Wang Li | 王力 | Propaganda specialist and part of the Cultural Revolution Group |
| Wenhui Bao | 文汇报 | A Shanghai-based newspaper |
| Wu Bangguo | 吴邦国 | Ranked number 2 in the current CCP hierarchy, Chairman of Standing Committee of NPC |
| Wu Lengxi | 吴冷西 | Head of People's Daily |
| Yang Shangkun | 杨尚昆 | Head of the Party General Office and a victim of the Cultural Revolution |
| Yao Wenyuan | 姚文元 | Shanghai leftist radical, later a member of the Gang of Four |
| Ye Jianying | 叶剑英 | Marshal who replaced Luo Ruiqing |
| Ye Qun | 叶群 | Wife of Lin Biao |
| Zhang Chunqiao | 张春桥 | Shanghai leftist radical, later a member of the Gang of Four |
| Zhu De | 朱德 | Co-founder of the PLA, old comrade of Mao |
