Chen Yi	陈毅	Great CCP military man, Shanghai mayor and Foreign minister
Dazibao	大字报	Big Character Poster
Gongye xue Daqing	工业学大庆	In Industry, study Daqing (China's largest oil field and refinery)
Guan Feng	关风	CCRG member
Hongshaorou	红烧肉	Pork with Hongshao sauce
Jiang Qing	江青	Mao's wife and CCRG deputy leader, also part of Gang of Four
Jinggangshan	井冈山	Mountains by the Jiangxi-Hunan border. Here is where the Red Army was born and where the survivors of the Shanghai Massacre fled to in 1927
Kang Sheng	康生	Advisor to the CCRG
Kangxi	康熙	Qing dynasty emperor, reigned 1661-1722
Laobaixing	老百姓	The Chinese people (old hundred surnames)
Nongye Xue Dazhai	农业学大寨	In Agriculture learn from Dazhai (a model commune)
Qin Benyu	戚本禹	CCRG member
Qufu	曲阜	Birthplace of Confucius, located between Jinan and Jining in Shandong
Shaoshan	韶山	Birthplace of Chairman Mao Zedong
Tan Zhenlin	谭震林	Great PLA Commissar and politician
Wang Hongwen	王洪文	Obscure worker from Shanghai (originally Jilin) who rose to the heights of power, also part of Gang of Four

<b>Wang Li</b>	<b>王力</b>	CCRG member
<b>Xu Xiangqian</b>	<b>徐向前</b>	Great PLA Military man
<b>Yan'an</b>	<b>延安</b>	The city in Shaanxi where the CCP regrouped after the Long March
<b>Yao Wenyuan</b>	<b>姚文元 张春桥</b>	CCRG member and later part of Gang of Four
<b>Zhang Chunqiao</b>	<b>张春桥</b>	CCRG member and later part of Gang of Four
<b>Zhongnanhai</b>	<b>中南海</b>	Compound adjacent to the Forbidden City where China's highest leaders lived
<b>Zunyi</b>	<b>遵义</b>	City in Guizhou 贵州 Province. Site of an historic conference where Mao assumed leadership of the CCP
