PINYIN / TERM	CHINESE	ENGLISH / MEANING
Alfred Sze	施肇基	Shī Zhào jī, Albert Sze Sao-ke, ROC era statesman and diplomat (also first Chinese to graduate from Cornell)
CT Wang	王正廷	1882-1961, CT Wang, Chinese foreign minister, finance minister, Justice minister and a premier to boot
Duàn Qírui	段祺瑞	1865-1936, Chinese warlord and multiple times the Premier of the Republic of China
fèizhǐ	废纸	Waste paper
Fùdàn University	复旦大学	One of the top universities in China, located in Shanghai
Guāngxù Emperor	光绪帝	Reigned 1875-1908, second to the last Qing Emperor
Jiāding	嘉定	District in northeast Shanghai
Jiāozhōu	胶州	The area that is called Qingdao today
Jīnmén Mǎzǔ Crisis	九三炮战	Also called the First Taiwan Strait Crisis 1954-55 (as opposed to the Second one in 1958)
Liáodōng peninsula	辽东半岛	Contested area in Liaoning province that extends into the Bohai Sea. The city of Dalian is located at the tip of the peninsula
Lín chéng jié chē àn	临城劫车案	Línchéng Incident
Lǐ Hóngzhāng	李鸿章	Late Qing Era politician and diplomat. Signed more than his fair share of unequal treaties
Oei Hui lan / Huáng Huilán	黄蕙兰	1889-1992 former first lady of the Rep. of China, 3rd wife of Wellington Koo
Pǔyí	溥仪	The Last Emperor of the Qing Dynasty
Qianlong Emperor	乾隆帝	Long lasting and long reigning Qing emperor, lived 1711-1799
Shandong	山东	Coastal province in north China

Shirley Young	楊思琦	a businesswoman of great renown...and a founding member of the Committee of 100
The Mukden Incident	九一八事变	An incident on 9-18-31 used by Japan to invade Manchuria
Wellington Koo	顾维钧	January 29, 1888 - November 14, 1985
Wēihǎiwèi	威海卫	City bordering Yantai, leased to Britain from 1898-1930. Also known as Port Edward
Yán Yòuyùn	严幼韵	Juliana Young, fourth wife of Wellington Koo, mother to Shirley Young
Yáng Guāngshēng	杨广胜	Chinese diplomat and first husband of Juliana Young. Also known as Clarence Kuangson Young
Zhāng Xuéliáng	张学良	Son of Zhang Zuolin, also called The Young Marshall. The brains behind the Xian Incident
Zhāng Zuòlín	张作霖	Manchurian Warlord and major figure in the 1920's
